PEOPLE'S COLLEGE

Established in the year 1984, People's college Mokokchung has its beginnings on the premises of Fazl Ali College (FAC), offering evening classes to cater to the growing number of employed adult students whose work schedule prevented them from attending college at traditional times. The students then were voluntarily taught by professors from FAC until a Government order to introduce the science stream no longer made it possible to continue teaching those classes at FAC campus.

The college then shifted its base to the present day campus located in the heart of the town at Kumlong ward. Backed by a group of dedicated well-wishers and through their contributions and donations, People's College established itself as a full-fledged college moving on from what was then called a "Night College" and opening its doors to full time students. In 1996 the Nagaland University granted the college the degree provisional affiliation, facilitating honours in all the departments.

With the expansion of the college, the Governing Board under the chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner and the Board of Trustee

under the chairmanship of Shri. Meren Paul, made a decision in the year 2004 to transfer the proprietorship of the college to Lt.N.I.Jamir& family under the full guardianship of Shri.Alemtemshi Jamir IAS (Rtd). This marked a new chapter in the history of the college while simultaneously charting a new course for the future.

Today People's College is one of the premier college in Mokokchung Town and it continues to strive for excellence in higher education, while augmenting greater educational standards in the state of Nagaland. At present the college is awaiting Accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in line with the college's aim to establish itself as a centre of academic excellence.

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ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

The college being affiliated to Nagaland University follows the CBCS as introduced by Nagaland University from 2022 under NEP 2020.

Admission process begins soon after the declaration of the NBSE results. The college offers general course in the following subjects.

PASS COURSE:

(I) English

(ii) History

(iii) Economics

(iv) Political Science (v) Sociology

(vi) Education

Any student who has passed the HSSLC or equivalent examination is eligible for admission in the Pass course. The filled in application form provided with the prospectus is to be submitted on the specified date(s).

Documents to be submitted during admission:

- Duplicate copies of Marks sheet, Admit card (Hall ticket), Testimonials, Pass certificate of the last examination (HSLC & HSSLC). Original documents must be produced at the time of admission.
- Registration card in original.
- Duplicate copies of ST.SC or OBC
- Four (4) identical copies of recent passport size good quality colour photo.
- Original Migration certificate if the student is from a different university/board other than NU/NBSE

ADMISSION/TRANSFER OF STUDENTS:

Admission fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances. However admission fees to the 5th Semester shall be refunded in case the student(s) fail to clear the 4th Semester exams. Transfer of college within the town/district in the middle of the academic session shall be permitted only incase of transfer of the student's parents to a different district, etc.

UNIFORM/DRESS CODE:

- The college provides full set of uniform, to be worn everyday unless informed otherwise. On days when uniforms are exempted a student is expected to dress decently.
- Students will be charged a separate amount for the uniform and Tshirts which is non-refundable.

EXAMINATION AND HOLIDAYS:

End Semester Examination in each paper will be held at the end of every semester as per the Nagaland University schedule.

 A student must secure a minimum of 75% attendance, to be eligible to sit for the End Semester University Examination.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE:

- It is mandatory for all students to have a minimum of 75% attendance failing which he/she will not be allowed to write any exam.
- If a student is absent for more than 3 days, he/she is to attach a supporting document/certificate from the competent authority with the college leave form failing which the college authority shall take appropriate action as laid down in the Nagaland University laid down Semester system guidelines.

STUDENT SUPPORT/ACTIVITIES:

In line with the commitment of the college to provide a conducive environment for learning, the college offers a wide range of care and support services to make the college life of students not only worthwhile academic learning experience but also one that is enriching for the students future.

- People's college Students Union (PCSU) had existed from the inception of the college. Election to the PCSU is held annually through which the student leaders looks after the welfare of the student community.
